#### COVID-19 Archery, Pistol and Rifle outdoor Range Guidelines

- Sanitizer will be provided by LSC. Clubhouses will not open.
- Social distancing is required; there is to be no congregating.
- Only use alternating bays.  
There should be an empty slot between you and other shooters.
- If there are people waiting to use the range, please limit yourself to a half-hour of shooting.
- Police your own brass (only); avoid contact with other people's brass.
- **Be sure and fly the Red Flag in the red box on the Flagpole.**

**Building Target Frame** instructions have been posted on the website Firearms page for you to make and use at the ranges when practicing. The committee will make a couple for the range so you can see what they look like and how they are put up. Follow the measurements and you should be good to go. Thanks

**Remember** there are no shot guns used on the Rifle range except to sight in with slugs only. There is no skeet or trap shooting.

**We do not allow skeet or trap shooting on the Club property. Our insurance does not allow it. Even if hand thrown, it is not allowed. Sorry**
